ARGREEMENT BETWEEN IVY TECH COMMUNITY COLLEGE

AND

UNIVERSITY OF SOUTHERN INDIANA FOR TRANSFER OF CREDITS EARNED IN THE

ASSOCIATE OF SCIENCE IN SOCIAL AND BEHAVIORAL SCIENCE INTO THE BACHELOR OF SCIENCE IN PSYCHOLOGY

The purpose of this agreement is to provide a mechanism for transfer of credits earned in the Associate of Science in Social and Behavioral Science offered by Ivy Tech Community College of Indiana to the Bachelor of Science degree in Psychology offered by the University of Southern Indiana.

Over the last several years faculty and staff from both institutions have worked to build a relationship of trust and cooperation to insure that students can advance from associate degree to baccalaureate degree attainment and beyond. This agreement is a significant step forward for USI and Ivy Tech in helping students reach their educational and career goals. Specific transfer agreements in this document are constructed so that a student may earn the first two years of a baccalaureate degree at the community college. Courses were selected that fulfill general education core requirement of both institutions with some transfer courses also fulfilling requirement in the degree majors at USI.

Students transferring from any A.S. or A.A degree are subject to the same admission and academic policies as other applicants to the University of Southern Indiana. Transfer students are also subject to specific baccalaureate degree program admissions requirements.

Ivy Tech Community College and the University of Southern Indiana will continue to work cooperatively to provide guidance and advising to students in all transfer programs.

Both institutions retain the right to change their curriculum and agree to inform the other institution's administration and program faculty of such changes as they relate to the conditions of this agreement.

Both institutions agree to review this agreement once each year to monitor changes and to share information and ideas for improving the success of students.

This agreement shall be in effect for fall 2007.
