



SANE-P® CERTIFICATION TESTING REQUIREMENTS:

1. Current, unrestricted licensure as a Registered Nurse (RN) or Advanced Practice Registered Nurse (APRN).
2. Practice as a Registered Nurse (RN) for at least three years.
3. Completion of a Pediatric Sexual Assault Nurse Examiner course.
4. Completion of a Sexual Assault Nurse Examiner preceptorship.
5. Practice as a Sexual Assault Nurse Examiner (SANE) for a minimum of 300 hours within the past 3 years (at least 200 hours with the intended exam population).

Practice includes any combination of the following activities:

- A. Providing direct patient care as a SANE**
 - Provide medical forensic examinations in person or via telehealth
 - Aid in STI evaluations/treatment
 - Mental health care for victims of sexual violence
- B. Taking on call shifts to respond to patients as a SANE**
 - This applies to paid and unpaid on-call hours
 - On call hours apply even if a patient was not seen during those hours
- C. Teaching/precepting SANEs**
- D. Consultation on SANE issues/cases**
 - Policy work
 - Testimony
 - Community education
 - Sexual Assault Response Team
- E. Engaging in peer review of SANE cases**
