

## The English Teaching Major

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### GPA for Graduation and Admission to Clinical Internship (Student Teaching)

- ‘C’ or better in *all* courses in the candidate’s degree program
- 2.75 GPA overall
- 2.75 GPA in the ENGT major (and any other majors)
- 2.75 GPA in the Secondary Education minor (and any other minors)

### Stages in the Education Program

- 1) EDUC 206 (Exceptionalities) and EDUC 221 (Diversity and Equity)
- 2) EDUC 283 (Explorations, *includes field experience*; fall or spring); prerequisites:
  - a. EDUC 221 (co-req)
  - b. Completion of Core 39 Foundation courses: ENG 101 and 201; CMST 101 or 107; MATH 107 or 111 or 114 or 215 or 230
  - c. Overall GPA of 2.75
  - d. Background checks; email Dr. Sarah Wannemuehler (scwannemue@usi.edu)
- 3) English Teaching Interview (see pp. 2-6)
  - a. Commonly scheduled the fall semester of a student’s junior year
  - b. Includes TK20 application
- 4) Application to the Education program on Tk20
  - a. Requires successful interview
  - a. Check with student to be sure all requirements are met, including GPA.
  - b. Email the ENGT coordinator to do a final check of the application.
- 5) EDUC 383/384 (Curriculum & Pedagogy, *includes field practicum*; ideally the last two semesters prior to clinical internship)
- 6) Application for internship
  - a. Attend fall orientation meeting **a full year** before student teaching
  - b. With advisor, submit application to Erin Hollinger in January
- 7) EDUC 458/473 (clinical internship; fall or spring)
  - a. Must have completed **all** other coursework, meeting GPA requirements
- 8) Two licensure exams (ELA content and secondary level pedagogy; see IDOE website or contact Erin Hollinger)
