AGREEMENT BETWEEN VINCENNES UNIVERSITY NUTRITION & DIETETICS—A.S. DEGREE AND

UNIVERSITY OF SOUTHERN INDIANA FOOD & NUTRITION MAJOR, DIETETICS SPECIALTY—B.S.

Statement of Intent

The purpose of this agreement is to provide a framework for the transfer of credits earned in the Associate of Science degree at Vincennes University (VU) to the Bachelor of Science Degree in the Food & Nutrition Major, Dietetics Specialty at the University of Southern Indiana (USI).

The faculty of both institutions have worked together to develop the attached listing of course equivalencies, course requirements for the associate degree, and course requirements for the completion of the baccalaureate degree. The agreement is in effect for courses taken beginning Spring 2018. This agreement will be reviewed every three years by representatives of both institutions.

All course work taken prior to Spring 2018 will be evaluated by USI faculty to determine transferability of course work. This agreement, including any modifications, may be reviewed by either institution upon request. Both institutions agree to keep the other aware of curriculum changes as they occur. While both parties to the agreement understand its purpose is to maximize transfer opportunities for student, they also recognize that limits may be placed on courses accepted under the provisions of this agreement, should the student subsequently decide to change to another program not covered by the agreement.
